As part of the Saskatchewan Safe School Plan, there is a section that outlines Safe Alternatives that focus on the contingency plans to ensure the continuation of education in a safe learning environment. There are four levels of education delivery:

- **Level 1:** Full in-class learning with some additional measures to ensure student and staff safety.
- **Level 2:** Full in-class learning – Mask usage for students and staff, as per the guidance provided to school divisions by Saskatchewan's Chief Medical Health Officer.
- **Level 3:** Reduced in-class learning. This may include establishing cohorts and hybrid learning models as considerations.
- **Level 4:** Transition to alternative learning opportunities offered by divisions. **Which means transitioning to mandatory remote learning.**

Northern Lights School Division #113 will implement **Level 4** in all of our schools.
